

Poster Presentation Guideline

Dates of poster presentation: April 3rd (Fri) and 4th (Sat) 2020

A poster should be self-contained and self-explanatory, allowing different viewers to proceed on their own while leaving the author free to discuss points raised in inquiry. The poster session offers a more intimate forum for discussion.

Procedure

- Poster should be displayed as soon as you finish the registration on April 2nd (Thu).
- Presenters are expected to collect all required materials (thumbtacks) from the Poster Reception Desk.

Poster

- Please notice the maximum dimensions when preparing your poster presentation.
- It is the presenter's responsibility to prepare the poster following the maximum dimensions of the poster board.
- Your presentation number can be confirmed in the abstract book.
- The presentation number will be written in the poster board.
- An award ribbon is attached to the poster which gets the poster award.
- The winner of the poster award should attend the ceremony on April 4th (Sat).

DIMENSIONS OF THE POSTER BOARD

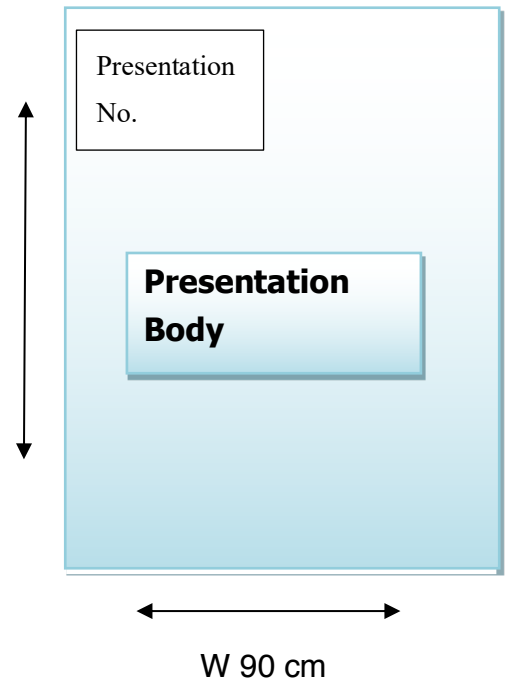
Height: 210 cm

Width: 90 cm

- Presenters are strongly advised to arrange the poster in the following order.

1-Aim/ 2-Method /3-Results/ 4-Conclusions H 210 cm

- Posters must be displayed in ENGLISH only.
- The main presentation body is expected to be legible.
(i.e. Font size = 16pts – 20pts)
(text height - 10mm – 15mm)
- Your presentation body must not exceed the board.



Presenters are expected to be present in front of their poster panels on April 3rd (Fri) between 7:00 – 8:00 am and 4th (Sat) between 8:00 – 8:40 am

Removal

- Posters are required to be removed by end of the conference.
- Presenters are to arrange to retrieve their own posters.
- If you are unable to retrieve your poster, it will be discarded at the end of the conference.
